

***AcquiTerme “CROP”*: technical report**

It would be sufficient those initials for labeling the results of the analyses performed on the samples of ears received: I.E.G. (= insufficient elements of judgment).

In fact, as in the case of Pontecurone, the ears that have been sent are not complete of the stems that support them, so it is impossible to appraise the folding, the fattening (or enlargement) and the growth of the knots. Moreover, the sampling of the soil is missing. On this subject, we invite everyone to have a look at “crop investigation protocol”, published on the website "Galileo. CUN Parma" and linked from the website of the National Ufologic Centre.

Only detail to be underlined: **all** the ears inside the pictogram and inside the main circle, they are folded up not to nodal level but in the insertion point of the ear on the summit of the stem (see picture), contrarily to those picked up outside the pictogram.

Have not been found (or the results are not satisfactory) other details recovered during the investigation.
